Artist of the Month

Both series presented by Thomas Wrede on view this month at Cristinerose

Gallery were taken at a popular amusement park in his native Gemany.

The first body of work, "Magic Worlds", shows various perspectives of landscapes

(Japanese Gardens or the American


Natural West) that gratify our quest for the foreign and exotic. Devoid of human presence, (the exact opposite of the common expectation of amusement parks), the photograph's perfect composition leaves us wondering which aspect of the image is artificial or real.

The second series. "Magic Feelings" offers a sharp contrast to the almost surreal landscape views of the park. Here, Thomas Wrede shows close up shots of roller coaster riders, focusing on the anger, fear or pleasure they experience. Executed in black and white, these images furnish insight into how children and adults (young and old) cope with their emotions. What draws people to roller coaster rides is what initially started Thomas Wrede on this series. The images fail to provide any answer unless the attraction is linked to Wrede's "magic".
