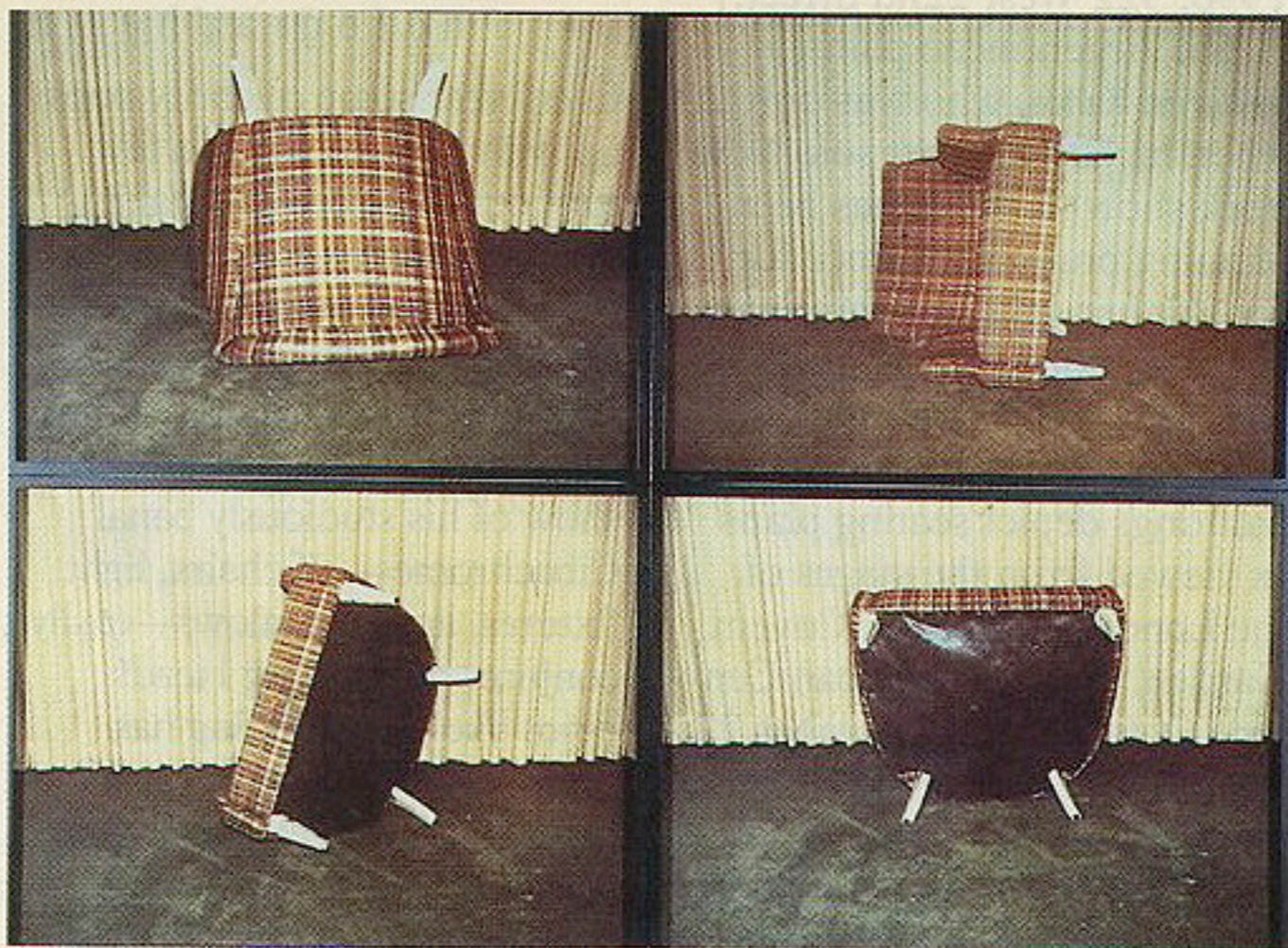

Every year some celebrity pops up with a photo show; a few turn out to be better at taking pictures than one would think. But **David Byrne** actually *was* an art student and a photographer before he became a very skinny musician in an oversized suit. A show of his studiously banal Cibachromes—of chairs, light fixtures, and bungalows—easily conjures old Talking Heads lyrics like “My building has every convenience! It’s going to make it easy to get things done.” (October 21–November 22; Cristinerose Gallery, 395 West Broadway.)
