Photographic tableaux of the artist herself and her twin, also played by herself, wearing odd costumes and surrounded by absurd and enigmatic symbols. The pictures are mysterious, sometimes sexy and often funny. In "Albatross," the sisters appear in a green room dressed in rose-pink 18th-century gowns, each with a chicken hanging upside down around her neck (Johnson).
