shock therapy inspired this pretentious but
not uninteresting show of videos, sculpture
and photography. It includes Paul McCarthy's
weird and funny video "Family Tyranny,"
Carolee Schneemann's inane video "Meat
Joy," Michèle Blondel's blasphemous confessionals and Beth B's "Plaything No. 10," in
which a crawling baby doll drags another on a
conveyor belt (Johnson).
