Through the miracle of digital technology, this Japanese-born New York artist produces oddly banal photomontages depicting ordinary tourists on the moon, with the earth looming over the horizon in every case. In another series, tourists are inserted into video game scenes. Something about the disconnected rootlessness of modern life is implied, but these works are less amusing than they should be (Johnson).
