THOMAS WREDE, "Magic Worlds, Magic Feelings," Cristinerose, 529 West 20th Street, (212) 206-0297 (through April 3). This German photographer presents a series of vivid color views of German amusement parks where things like the American Southwest landscape or an African elephant habitat are cheesily simulated. Devoid of visitors, the scenes are subtly surrealistic. Mr. Wrede also offers small, oddly romantic black-and-white portraits of ecstatic roller coaster riders grimacing, screaming or laughing (Johnson).
